BOARD MEETING

July 6, 2023 12:02 p.m. Ledger Office

The Whitehall Chamber of Commerce Board Meeting was called to order at 5:02 PM by President Liz Pullman. Current Business

a. Treasurer's Report

Sherre

Sherre reported that the Main account has \$61,955.62, Rodeo account is \$25,441.37, and Savings account is \$10,017.98 for a total of \$97,414.97. The Debit card was closed for suspicious activity. New cards have been ordered. Sherre has been actively cleaning up QB.

b. ARPA Liz

We are waiting on the ARPA Grant to come in. Leslie has asked for a breakdown of how funds will be allocated. We discussed Event Ads - \$5,000, Chamber Ads - \$2,000, Shop Local - \$2,000, Misc. - \$1000.

There were approximately 300 people who attended throughout the day. The Whimsical Wonders have asked Liz to manage the event next year to keep them organized and on track. There were discussions about making some changes like later in the day to transition into the evening for houses to be lit up, adding some shade sails, extra sand bags and more signage.

d. Frontier Days

The Town asked for an \$800 donation from the Chamber. Western Legacy Center will have vendors out at their location. There are 44 paid vendors. We discussed sending out our vendor event sign ups ASAP. We should market to Anaconda and Deer Lodge vendors. Missoula Food Truck. The Chamber Board will decorate businesses the week of the 17th. We have 9 businesses signed up and Monique will decorate. Chamber BBQ will be on Thursday the 27th at 6pm with set up at 3pm at the Sunlight pavilion. Split Diamond Ranch and Jefferson Fresh Foods made donations to cover food and beverages. We would like to run it as a Free Community Dinner and invite newcomers and new business owners as well. We will still put out a few donation boxes. Friday vendor check in at 8am at Sherre's office. Brandy Yates will help with Check-In. Parade starts at 11 with line up at 10am. Tim & Civil Air Patrol will manage the parade route. Lorie and Rhia plan to help as well. Terri Casagranda is the Grand Marshall. Phil & Laura will have Kids Activities/Rodeo on the Main Street Green. Magic and Talent Show 1-4pm. World Record event 4-6pm. Each team is paying \$10 to participate and Business Sponsors are \$100 per event. Porta Potties and road closures have been submitted and approved. Town Rodeo is at 6pm followed by the
